

Blessed Sacrament Redevelopment – Community Update

Dear Neighbors,

We want to provide a monthly update on construction activities at the Blessed Sacrament redevelopment site at 361 Centre Street. Construction has progressed into selective demolition and early site preparation activities, and we appreciate your continued patience.

Current Construction Activities

- Selective interior demolition of the church, including first-floor areas and ceilings.
- Site work focused on preparing surfaces in advance of pile and foundation installation.
- Masonry mobilization, including trailer setup, staging, and demolition of select openings.
- Noise levels during these activities are expected to remain minimal.

Upcoming Construction Activities

- Soil improvement work, including the installation of piles to improve subsurface conditions.

Construction Hours of Operation

Work will continue to occur **Monday through Friday, between 7:00 AM and 3:00 PM**. Occasional Saturday work will also occur, but not without formal approval from ISD.

Ongoing Site Safety and Monitoring

Vibration monitoring equipment has been in place and collecting readings since September 26, 2025 to ensure that demolition and construction activities remain within safe limits for nearby structures. Additionally, overhead scaffold protection, perimeter lighting, and updated fencing configurations have been installed for public safety and accessibility.

We appreciate your continued patience and cooperation as we move through this next phase of work. Our construction team remains committed to minimizing disruption wherever possible.
