






RELOCATION


Temporary relocation on-site is likely to facilitate construction, but our goal is to minimize the number of moves to the extent possible

Services at Veterans' Home in Chelsea

- Existing residents will continue to receive services from the Commonwealth until they
 have moved into new affordable housing units managed by Pennrose.
- Services will be closely coordinated between services staff at the Domiciliary and Pennrose to ensure that transition is as smooth as possible
- Veteran Resource Center will be the hub for accessing services and building community
- There will be full-time on-site case management and resident service coordination staff
- Services to be provide will include case management, transportation, meals, recreational therapy, recovery support groups, mental health treatment, and more
